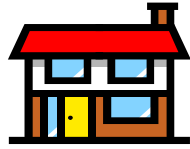

LIVING APART – PARENTING TOGETHER

Fewer than half of America's children can expect to live their childhood in a home with both of their biological parents, whether their parents are divorced or were never married.

“Living Apart – Parenting Together” is a two-evening, four-hour class or a one-day four-hour class that encourages parents living apart to work out parenting decisions without putting their children in the middle. The class meets the parent education guidelines established by the Supreme Court of Virginia.
